Provisions:

Students who are participating in a professional graduate education program may accompany a licensed independent practitioner on-staff at this facility and participate in the following function under the direct supervision of the sponsoring physician:

1. Students may participate in activities considered standard training in their graduate medical education program and must supply a copy to the Medical Staff office prior to beginning rotation.
2. Direct patient care, treatment and/or services must be under the direct supervision of their sponsoring physician who assumes direct responsibility for that student.
3. All orders must be co-signed by the attending sponsoring physician before orders may be taken off the chart by hospital staff.
4. Student must identify that they are not an on-staff physician and signature of orders must be signed by student with appropriate credentials (i.e., MS, OMS or NP student).
5. Prior to beginning rotation, student must supply the Medical Staff office with the following:
 - a. Current Medical Liability coverage
 - b. Letter from Resident Director or Coordinator verifying good standing within the educational entity.
 - c. Copy of current KY licensure (if appropriate)
 - d. Copy of signed sponsorship by on-staff physician at this facility
 - e. Copy of criminal background checks within the past year for licensed residents or equivalents
 - f. Copy of recent TB skin test
 - g. Copy of a valid picture ID issued by a state or federal agency (e.g. drivers license or passport)
